Castra 2023

Akvarel je ena izmed najstarejših slikarskih tehnik, na videz lahka, izvajalsko pa zelo zahtevna. Ostalim slikarskim zvrstom je enakovredna, čeprav v preteklosti po krivici zapostavljena. Akvarel je primeren zlasti za študije, skice, za beleženje vtisov in za intimno slikarstvo. Njegovo področje je predvsem krajina, veduta, scenska skica in miniatura, redkeje kompozicija in portret. Umetniki so pogosto v akvarelni tehniki kolorirali grafične liste in risbe, lahko pa je akvarel tudi samostojno izrazno sredstvo brez vsake podložne risbe, ki bi služila kot okostje. V primerjavi z oljnim ali akrilnim slikarstvom je prednost akvarela v tem, da ne zahteva dolgotrajnih priprav, sredstva so lahko dostopna ter lahko prenosljiva. Prav ta mobilnost omogoča slikanje v naravi, ne da bi slikar moral s sabo nositi cel atelje. Barve za ustvarjanje te zvrsti so vodene, hitro se sušijo, popravljanje pa je zaradi lazurnega nanašanja skoraj nemogoče. Akvarel lahko prenese subtilne barvne prehode, nasičenost prostora z zrakom, bogastvo vsakega tona.

Nekaterim akvarelistom je dovolj, da naslikajo le hitri zapis dogodka, opravila, pozabljenega običaja, navad, drugi hočejo, in nekateri tudi zmorejo, vdihniti akvarelju nekaj več. Velikokrat smo v dilemi, ko se sprašujemo, ali naj bo akvarel v službi motiva ali motiv v službi akvarela. Lahko zatrdimo da oboje, če je prisotna ustvarjalna poštenost. Nenavadnost ali všečnost, ki sta sami sebi namen, ne bi smeli najti poti do gledalca, ki mu je vodilo humanizem in uravnotežen občutek do lepote.

Strokovna komisija, ki so jo sestavljali Dejan Mehmedovič, predsednik žirije, ter člani Vladimir Bačič, Lucijan Bratuš, Azad Karim in Bogdan Vrčon, je pregledala prispela dela in naredila izbor avtorjev ter izbrala nagrade in diplome.

Watercolour is one of the oldest painting techniques, seemingly easy, but very demanding in execution. It is equal to other painting genres, although it has been unfairly neglected in the past. Watercolour is especially suitable for studies, sketches, recording impressions, and intimate painting. Its field is mainly landscape, veduta, scenic sketch, and miniature, less often composition, and portrait. Artists often colour graphic sheets and drawings in the watercolour technique, but watercolour can also be an independent means of expression without any underlying drawing that would serve as a skeleton. Compared to oil or acrylic painting, the advantage of watercolour is that it does not require lengthy preparations, and the means are easily accessible and easily portable. It is this mobility that makes it possible to paint outdoors, without the painter having to carry an entire studio with him or her. The colours for creating this genre are water-based and dry quickly. Correction is almost impossible due to the glaze application. Watercolour can withstand subtle colour transitions, the saturation of space with air, and the richness of each tone.

For some watercolour artists, it is enough to paint only a quick record of an event, task, forgotten custom, or habit; others want, and some are even able, to breathe something more into the watercolour. We are often in a dilemma when we wonder whether the watercolour should serve the motif or the motif should serve the watercolour. We can say yes to both if there is creative honesty. Quirkiness or likeability, which are ends in themselves, should not find their way to a viewer guided by humanism and a balanced sense of beauty.

The professional committee consisting of Dejan Mehmedović, President of the committee, and members Vladimir Bačić, Lucijan Bratuš, Azad Karim and Bogdan Vrćon, reviewed the submitted artworks and made a selection of artists and chose awards and honourable mention certificates.

Strokovna komisija

Na letošnjo razstavo 5. mednarodnega festivala akvarela Castra 2023 je bilo sprejetih 160 avtorjev iz 36 držav. Dela so raznovrstna, izgotovljena v različnih slogovnih načinih, večinoma v celoti v tehniki akvarela, nekatera v mešani tehniki s prevlado akvarelnega pristopa. Izrazno se prispeli artefakti ravno tako precej razlikujejo med seboj in se vsebinsko lotevajo različnih tematik. Vsekakor prevladujejo figuralna dela s krajinsko motiviko, temu sledijo tihozitja, žanrske slike, nekatera dela prestopajo v polje abstraktne podobe.

Akvarel je starodavna in zelo hvaležna slikarska tehnika, ki s specifično prelivnostjo, mehkobo in transparentnostjo kolorita, lahko tudi ostrino linije, omogoča obsežno likovno izraznost. Dela, ki jih razstavljamo, so večinoma visoke oziroma ustrezne likovne kvalitete, tako da je imela žirija pri ocenjevanju precej težko delo.

Strokovna žirija je pri svojem delu upoštevala splošne kriterije kakovosti, ki veljajo za likovno umetnost oziroma specifično za akvarel. Pri izboru žirija ni imela drugih omejitev. V obravnavo so bile zajete vse tehnike, motivi in koncepti akvarela, upoštevana je bila izvirnost ideje ter pristop k reševanju likovnih problemov. Skozi to prizmo je žirija sprejela odločitev in izbrala dela, ki izstopajo, in podelila nagrade oziroma diplome.

Žirija je sprejela sklep, da nagrade 5. mednarodnega festivala akvarela Castra 2023 prejmejo naslednji avtorji: Ana Undurraga, Luka Popič, Ivan Miloushev, David Hrvatin in Damir Facan Grdiša.

Diplome pa prejmejo: Efer Aguilar, Manhal Aldabbagh, Marta Frei, Tanja Hočevvar, Silva Karim, Stanko Kolbezen, Marina Legovini, Klavdija Marušić, Anna Pogrzebacz in Raimonda Raulus.

Professional committee

A total of 160 artists from 36 countries were admitted to the exhibition of the 5th International Watercolour Festival Castra 2023. The artworks are diverse, created in different stylistic ways, mostly entirely in the watercolour technique, some in a mixed technique with a predominance of the watercolour approach. The artworks are also quite different from each other and deal with different topics in terms of content. Figurative works with landscape motifs prevail, followed by still life and genre paintings, while some artworks move into the field of abstract imagery.

Watercolour is an ancient and very graceful painting technique, which with its specific iridescence, softness, and transparency of colour, as well as the sharpness of the line, enables extensive artistic expression. The works that are exhibited are mostly of high or adequate artistic quality, so the committee had a rather difficult job in evaluating them.

In its work, the professional committee took into account the general quality criteria that apply to fine art and specifically to watercolour. The committee had no other restrictions with their selection. All watercolour techniques, motifs and concepts were taken into consideration, as well as the originality of the idea and the approach to solving artistic problems. Through this prism, the committee made a decision and selected artworks that stand out, and awarded prizes or honourable mention certificates.

The committee decided that the prizes of the 5th International Watercolour Festival Castra 2023 will be awarded to the following authors: Ana Undurraga, Luka Popić, Ivan Miloushev, David Hrvatin and Damir Facan Grdiša.

Honourable mention certificates are awarded to: Efer Aguilar, Manhal Aldabagh, Marta Frei, Tanja Hočevat, Silva Karim, Stanko Kolbezen, Marina Legovini, Klavdija Marušić, Anna Pogrzebacz and Raimonda Raulus.


